3.We are commanded to pray for our enemies:

St. Matthew 5,44 "But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to

them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;


Have you heard the Call to Prayer? Song of Solomon 2:10 - 14

Lord, Do It Again for Me – Psalms 85:1-7

- Consecrate yourself; Present your bodies totally to God Romans 12:1.
- We have to press(toward the mark of God's calling)
 God will spew you out if you are lukewarm (half hearted) saint
- Don't break your covenant with God
- If you need to be revived; get in the waters (living waters)

There's a Reason for the Call

- God does everything with a purpose.
- God is looking for someone who is willing to let Him get the glory out of their life. Just say yes to God
- Jeremiah 1:5 God's call is ageless and eternal and it does not change. Get to know God in a better way. Stay before Him in prayer until you receive what you need from Him; be specific God wants to reveal Himself to you so you can go out and share Him with others.

- If you respond to the call of God, he can use you.
- Respond to the call; God will use you; don't resist the call; embrace the call
- His call is not like others; its divine, anointed
- The summons to call you out of darkness to use you for His glory
- Jesus answered the call "Lo I come in the volume of the book"
- The difference between the Lord's call and the enemy's call is:
 - The enemy's call you name he will mess with you, your family and your finances
 - We got to know the voice of the Lord
 - We don't want to come to church every service and not know the call of God

Friday 10/22/10

Keep The Fire Burning Jeremiah 20:7-9

- It is important to hold on to what we have received from God's Word
- Set your affection on things above-Colossians 3:1. We can't please God if we are in the flesh.
- The enemy's purpose is to get us off track, off focus, off kilter from God
- We need to keep our enthusiasm for God
- Fire
 - Stimulates growth,
 - Use for signaling
 - Used for cooking
 - Use for generating heat
- The Holy Ghost
 - After you get saved, it is important to be filled with the Holy Ghost; He will lead you and guide you into all truth
 - He empowers you to be a witness for Christ
 - We say that we are filled with the Holy Ghost but we lack the love of God. We easily get "attitude" and have no power. We need to go back to the altar and tarry again
- We need God word for our lives Matthew 3:
- Fire can be distinguished. If you disconnect from God, the fire of the Holy Ghost will be distinguished.
- Parable of 10 virgins (Matthew 25th chapt); 5 were wise, 5 were foolish. The foolish didn't take enough oil
- What we need to do to keep the fire burning:
 - Stay on the altar-sacrifice ourselves to God-Romans 12:1
 - Get filled with the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking with tongues-
 - The Holy Ghost will lead and guide you into all truth.
 - The Holy Ghost empowers us to do the work of the Lord.
 - Get the Word of God-Matt 4:4

HOLINESS

- Is still commanded by God; it has not changed.
- Holiness starts inside and works outside. There is no reason to tell people to change outwardly if a change hasn't taken place inwardly.
- Is not an old "fogey" principle.

HOLINESS

- Is necessary for God's worship – Psalms 24:3-5
- None can seek God with it. Hebrews 12:14

God wouldn't ask us to live holy if it was not or possible to live holy.

God and Jesus Christ are holy and if we are following God, we should be holy. When you are going the wrong way, you should turn around.

THE CHARACTERISTICS OF HOLINESS

- God's character is the standard of holiness – Leviticus 19:2; 1 Peter 1:15
- The gospel is the standard of holiness - Isaiah 35:8
- Forgiveness Colossians 3:13
- Sanctification (Jesus Christ commands/desires it-Ephesians 5:25
- Christ is an example of holiness – Hebrews 7:27; 1 Peter 2:21
 - Jesus Christ lived, walked, talked and preached holiness!





- Hunger is a craving or urgent need for food
- Appetite is a craving for certain food; not necessarily hunger.
- Luke 4:2 Jesus hungered for food.
- Mat 21:19-21 Jesus hunger caused him to curse the fruitless fig tree.
- Hunger brought complaints from Israel
- Sin can cause spiritual hunger.
- Amos 8:11 states that there will be a hunger for the (hearing of) Word of God
- Hunger can be satisfied. Mat 5:6, Luke 6:21
- Hunger can be avoided. Proverbs 2:3
- Hunger after that is right and lawful.
- We have fleshly appetite; however if you go after the flesh, ye shall die. (Romans 8:13)
- Emotions, surroundings and mere availability can cause appetite; <u>you</u> don't have to be hungry to act on an appetite.
- You need not to indulge in your appetite-it may be good to you, but it can do you bad.—stay away from people who brings a bad reaction.

- If you feed your hunger, your appetite will diminish.
- Romans 13:14 put on the Lord Jesus Christ and don't make provision for your flesh.
- Ecclesiastes 6:7 we labor but we are still not satisfied.
- Isaiah 29:8 lets you know that you can be eating and drinking in your dreams but that won't satisfy you.
- Ego have an appetite—it wants to be "stroked"; stop fishing for compliments.
- What we should do to bring our appetites in subjection:
 - Avoid those that are given to fleshly appetites.
 - Daily devotion helps you to avoid other things.
 - Prayer.
 - Remove yourself from temptation.
 - o Focus on the Word of God.

Seek God's face 1 Chronicles 16:1


- Seek the Lord's face continually.


